

"Precious" Defined

- Timios "Held as of great price, i. e. precious: metaphorically, held in honor, esteemed, especially dear." (Thayer)
- 1. 1 Pet. 1:19 Blood of Christ.
- 2. 1 Pet. 2:4 Christ rejected of men, precious with God.
- 3. 2 Pet. 1:4 Precious promises.
- 4. Heb. 13:4 Marriage; cf. 1 Pet. 3:7
- 5. Rom. 12:10 Relation to other Christians.

"Precious" Defined

Polutimos – "Very valuable, of great price." (Thayer)

- 1. Mt. 13:46 Pearl of great price.
- 2. Jno. 12:3 Pound of ointment.
- 3. 1 Pet. 1:7 Faith more precious than gold.

"Precious" Defined

"Of great value or high price – Precious jewels "Highly esteemed or cherished – A precious friend

Antonym: cheap (Webster)

The Church Is Precious Because It Is purchased by the blood of Christ. Acts 20:28

Price determines value. Cf. Mt. 13:46

- ❖No higher price! Cf. Jno. 15:13
- For those NOT in the church, Christ shed His blood in vain!

Blood Purchased Redemption. 1 Pet. 1:18-19

- Man needs redemption.
 - Sin is presented as slavery and sinners as slaves. Jno. 8:32-36; Rom. 6:17,20; 2 Pet. 2:19.
 - Deliverance from sin is freedom. Gal. 5:1.

❖Redemption is "IN CHRIST." Eph 1:7; Rom. 3:24-25
For those NOT in the church, Christ shed
His blood in vain!

Blood Purchased Justification. Rom. 3:20-26; 5:9

- Man needs justification ...
 Freedom from condemnation. Rom. 8:1
 - Cannot be justified by "law keeping." Gal. 3:11

For those NOT in the church, Christ shed His blood in vain!

Blood Purchased Reconciliation. Eph. 2:13-16

- ❖Man needs reconciliation. Cf. Isa. 59:1-2
 - Man must be reconciled to be saved. Cf. Rom. 5:10
 - Reconciliation commanded. 2 Cor. 5:10

- As the body is the church (Eph. 1:22-23) and reconciliation is in the body, then reconciliation is possible ONLY in the church.
- For those NOT in the church, Christ shed His blood in vain!

Blood Purchased Sanctification. Eph. 5:25-26

- Man needs sanctification. Rom. 6:19-22
 Definition: "To purify by expiation, free from the guilt of sin" 1 Cor. 6:11 (Thayer)
- Sanctified by "washing of water with the word." Eph. 5:26
 - Saul of Tarsus. Acts 22:16; 9:18
 - Baptism into his death. Rom. 6:3-4
- For those NOT in the church, Christ shed His blood in vain!

The Church Is The Body Of The Saved Acts 2:47

- Those who are purchased by blood. Acts 20:28
 - The Redeemed. 1 Pet. 1:18-19
 - The Justified. Rom. 3:20-26
 - The Reconciled. Eph. 2:13-16
 - The Sanctified. Eph. 5:25-26

For those NOT in the church ,Christ shed His blood in vain!

The precious church will be presented a "glorious" church. Eph. 5:26-27

- * "Metaphorically, a glorious Church, signifying the Church adorned in pure and splendid raiment as a bride (Eph 5:27)" (The Complete Word Study Dictionary)
- "Figuratively equivalent to free from sin, (Eph 5:27)." (Thayer)
- ➤ Those NOT in the church, are NOT so honored. Christ shed His blood in vain!
