SANCTIFICATION:

- *1 Cor 6:9-10 “Or know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with men, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.*
- *Verse 11 And such were some of you: but ye were **washed, but ye were sanctified,** but ye were **justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God.*

SANCTIFICATION:

What Is Sanctification?

- *Hagiazo* “To separate from profane things and dedicate to God.” (Strong’s)
- “To purify by expiation: free from the guilt of sin; to purify internally by renewing of the soul.” (Strong’s)

SANCTIFICATION:

What Is Sanctification?

- *Hagiazo* used of:
 - The gold adorning the Temple and of the gift laid on the altar. Mt. 23:17,19
 - Food. 1 Tim. 4:5
 - The unbelieving spouse of a believer. 1 Cor. 7:14
 - The ceremonial cleansing of the Israelites. Heb. 9:13
 - The Father's Name. Luke 11:2

SANCTIFICATION:

What Is Sanctification?

Hagiazo used of:

- The consecration of the Son by the Father. John 10:36
- The Lord Jesus devoting Himself to the redemption of His people. John 17:19
- The setting apart of the believer for God. Acts 20:32
- What the Death of Jesus does for the believer. Heb. 2:11; 10:10, 13:12
- The separation of the apostles from the world
— by the Father through the Word. John 17:14-17, 19

SANCTIFICATION:

What Is Sanctification?

Hagiazo used of:

- The believer who turns away from such things as dishonor God and His gospel. 2 Tim 2:21
- The acknowledgment of the Lordship of Christ. 1 Pet. 3:15
(from Vine's Expository Dictionary)

SANCTIFICATION:

What Is Sanctification?

Hagiazo used of:

- The root from which the word "*sanctify*" comes is the same as that from which the word "*saint*" is also derived.
- We are "*sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that call upon the name of the Lord Jesus Christ in every place*" (1 Cor. 1:2).

SANCTIFICATION:

“Who / What Sanctifies?”

- Blood of Christ (grace and power). Heb. 13:12
- Holy Spirit (agent of our sanctification). 2 Thess. 2:13-14 (1 Pet. 1:2).
 - The word is powerful. James 1:21
 - The power for the sanctification and edification of the saved is in the same gospel. John 17:17; 1 Thessalonians 4:1-7; 1 Peter 2:1-3; Ephesians 4:17-21
- Obedience to the gospel. Rom. 6:17-22.
- **God's grace** (blood of Christ) combined with **man's faith** (obey gospel).

SANCTIFICATION:

“For Whom Is Sanctification Provided?”

- All who need freedom / separation from sin. Rom. 6:15-23

SANCTIFICATION:

“Where Is Sanctification?”

- In the church.

*Eph. 5:25-26 “Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself up for it; **that he might sanctify it,** having cleansed it by the washing of water with the word.”*

SANCTIFICATION:

“When Are We Sanctified?”

1 Cor. 12:13 “For in one Spirit were we all **baptized into one body.**” (the church Eph. 1:22-23)

Gal. 3:26-27 “For ye are all sons of God, through faith, in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were **baptized into Christ** did put on Christ.”

1 Cor. 6:11 “**Washed, Justified, Sanctified.**” (cf. Acts 18:8)

Eph. 5:25-27 “Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself up for it; that he might **sanctify it**, having cleansed it by the **washing of water with the word**, that he might present the church to himself a glorious (church), not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.”

- Set Apart from Sin by the Blood of Jesus. Heb. 10:26-29
- *2 Tim 2:21 “If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honor, **sanctified**, meet for the master's use, prepared unto every good work.”*
