Ephesians 5:25-27


Ephesians 5:25-27, "Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself up for *it*; that he might sanctify **it**, having <u>cleansed</u> **it** by the washing of water with the word, that he might present the church to himself a glorious (church), not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that **it** should be holy and without blemish."

Salvation Is In The Church

<u>The church will be presented a "glorious" church</u>. Ephesians 5:26-27

- "Metaphorically, a glorious Church, signifying the Church adorned in pure and splendid raiment as a bride (Ephesians 5:27)" (The Complete Word Study Dictionary)
- "In good or in great esteem, of high repute.
 a. illustrious, honorable, esteemed 1 Cor 4:10
 b. notable, glorious: Luke 13:17
 - c. splendid: Luke 7:25 Eph 5:27"

"Figuratively equivalent to free from sin, (Ephesians 5:27)" (Thayer) Those NOT in the church, are NOT so honored.

- Those who put the kingdom first. Matthew 6:33
- Those willing to deny self. Matthew 16:24; cf. Romans 12:1ff
 - Former life. Ephesians 4:17; 1 Peter 4:1-4

Discipline.

- Begins with teaching. 2 Timothy 3:16-4:4; 1 Timothy 4:11; 1 Timothy 6:2
- Some teach error. Romans 16:17; cf. Acts 15
- Some walk disorderly. 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15;
 2 Thessalonians 3:6; cf. Philippians 3:16
- Some practice ungodliness. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; 1 Corinthians 5:6

- Church to glorify Him. Ephesians 3:21

To produce fruit. John 15:2, 8;

Proverbs 11:30, "The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; And he that is wise winneth souls."

- Seed of the kingdom is the word. Luke 8:11

- Message is urgent. Romans 9:1-3; 10:1-3
