Defining the Delight of God

- From the Hebrew, הפץ (hpṣ haphets) "be mindful of, attentive to, keep, protect" (BDB). "to incline to,...to bend" (Strong's). To focus toward one.
- The word describes one or something one takes pleasure in or is pleased with.
- In our text, God takes pleasure in & is pleased with David.

Defining the Delight of God

- Psalm 147:10-11 He does not delight in the strengths of the horse... the LORD takes pleasure in those who fear Him...
- 1 Kings 10:9 the Queen of Sheba to Solomon
- 1 Samuel 15:22 to King Saul after failing to obey the LORD
- Isaiah 62:4 of Jerusalem "...the LORD delights in you."

Defining the Delight of God

That God delights in us ought to be our goal

- 2 Corinthians 5:8-9 we make it our aim to be well pleasing to Him
- Colossians 1:10 walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him
- Psalm37:4, Delight yourself also in the LORD, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.
- Jeremiah 9:23-24 Let the wise man glory in...

David

- 2 Samuel 22:20 the object of our text.
- Acts 13:22 a man after My own heart...

Enoch

- Genesis 5:24 he walked with God.
- Hebrews 11:5 he did not see death because he pleased God

<u>Job</u>

- Job 1:8 "Have you considered My servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who fears God and shuns evil."
- Job 2:3 ...he holds to his integrity...

Abraham (Abram)

- Genesis 12:1-4 He goes just because the LORD told him to.
- Hebrews 11:8 he walked away from an idolatrous land
- Genesis 22 He is willing to offer up Isaac, trusting God. Note 22:12-18
- James 2:23, "And he was called the friend of God."

Moses

• Numbers 12:6-8 — ... I speak with him face to face, even plainly...

Daniel

- A servant taken captive to Babylon and faithfully serves the LORD for decades.
- After the fall of Babylon to Medo/Persia, he continues to faithfully serve the LORD
- Daniel 9:23 after praying, confessing, repenting and teaching (for Israel), Gabriel appears to him, "for you are greatly beloved." Also 10:11 & 19

<u>Jesus</u>

- He is our perfect example
- Matthew 3:17, "This is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased..." Also Matthew 17:5
 (cf. 2 Peter 1:17), John 12:28
- Philippians 2:9-11 God has highly exalted Him

Promises to those who delight in Him

- Numbers 14:8, ... if the LORD delights in us, He will bring us into this land (Joshua & Caleb)
- 2 Samuel 22:17-20 David (our text) looking back, he saw how often the LORD had protected, delivered him and sustained him
- Genesis 39:21 Joseph, the LORD showed him mercy and gave him favor with the prison keeper
- Nehemiah 2:8 The king granted them to me according to the good hand of my God upon me...

Promises to those who delight in Him

- 1 Peter 2:9, He delights in us. We are "His own special people..."
- Because we please Him:
 - He can use us Ephesians 2:10
 - He can give us what we need and guide us through this life (providentially) – Matthew 6:33
 - He can deliver us from temptations 1 Corinthians 10:13
 - Open doors for us Colossians 4:2-4
 - Hear and answer our prayers 1 Peter 3:12
 - Help us increase our faith & knowledge James 1:5
 - Draw us closer to Him James 4:8
