GIVE ME AN UNDERSTANDING HEART

1 Kings 3:9

- Most of us are familiar with the request of Solomon to God after he became king.
- Both YHWH and David intended for Solomon to be king (1 Chronicles 22:7-10)
- At Gibeon, YHWH grants Solomon anything he wants.
- Solomon requests wisdom.
- He is blessed with great wisdom, as well as wealth and fame.

- In our text, 1 Kings 3:9, his request is, "Give me an understanding heart to judge Your people..."
- Tonight, I would like to focus on that phrase. We ought to be requesting this of God regularly.
- Proverbs 4:7, Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding.
- James 1:5, If anyone lacks wisdom...
- What are some things we need a better understanding about?

- Before we can be useful to others, we must understand ourselves – physically & spiritually
- Only God would know us better

- 2 Corinthians 13:5, Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you are disqualified.
- Examine (NKJV) to test something to determine its strength. "tempted" –James 1:13-14, Matthew 4:1, Hebrews 4:15; Tested Heb. 11:17
- We scrutinize ourselves to see what we are made of cf. 1 Corinthians 9:27.

- 2 Corinthians 13:5, Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves.
- Test (NKJV) to observe, inspect, look over. To determine genuineness.
 - Cf. Luke 14:19, test oxen
 - 1 John 4:1, 1 Peter 1:7,
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:21, Galatians 6:3-4
- Romans 12:3 do not think more highly of yourself

- The better we understand ourselves, the better prepared we will be to help others.
- One reason this is important Matthew
 16:26 what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world and loses his own soul?

Of others

- A point of emphasis in our recent classes.
- We must understand that we are all equal before God Galatians 3:27-28, Acts 17:26,
 Genesis 1:26-27.
 - God show no favoritism Acts 10:34-35,
 - **2** Peter 3:9
- We must understand that we are all unique with different needs and approaches. 1 Corinthians 9:19-23, cf. Acts 13:13ff & Acts 17:22ff the audience mattered.

Of others

- The challenge is to balance these with better understanding.
- Principles we must ALWAYS apply:
 - Philippians 2:3-5 esteem others better...
 - Matthew 7:12 do unto others...
 - James 2:8 love your neighbor...
 - Philippians 2:15 let your light shine
 - Romans 12:17-18 live peaceably
 - Galatians 5:13 through love serve

We need a better understanding... To judge righteously

- Related to understanding others
- John 7:24 judge with righteous judgment
- Matthew 7:1-5 judging with wrong møtives (prejudice, hypocritical, appearance, preconceived ideas, etc.)
- Colossians 2:16 matters of liberty
- ► Matthew 6:14-15, James 2:13 forgiveness, mercy. It matters to God!

Of God's will

- Ephesians 5:17 commanded cf. 1 Corinthians 14:20
- Why is there so much misunderstanding concerning what God wants us to do and how?
- Because man does what he wants to do Matthew 15:8-9, Romans 1:18-25
- Proverbs 14:14, The backslider in heart will be filled with his own ways, But a good man will be satisfied from above.

Of God's will

- 2 Timothy 2:15, instead of following man's ways, I need to be diligent to handle accurately God's word (and will).
- Acts 17:11, like the Bereans
- **Ephesians 4:11-15,** God has given us teaching leaders to equip us to understand His will and not be easily deceived.

We need a better understanding... To discern between good and evil

- Applying God's word, we need understanding to choose what is good
- There is a clear difference in scripture
 - 2 Corinthians 6:14-17
 - **Romans 12:9**
 - Ephesians 5:11
- The "lists" Galatians 5:19-21, 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, Romans 1:27-32, 2 Timothy 3:1-5, etc.

To discern between good and evil

- Consider Paul's prayer to the Philippians,
- Philippians 1:9-10, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and understanding...
- Hebrews 5:12-14, by this time you ought to be teachers...
- Proverbs 14:15, The simple believes every word, But the prudent considers well his steps.

Of the church

- Matthew 16:18-19 built by Jesus
- **Ephesians 3:10-11,** a manifestation of His wisdom
- The church (each other). A group that seeks to stand true to His will. A support group with our same standard and interests to get to heaven!

Of the church

- WHY is there so much division?
- As above, it is placing man's desires above God's will
- 1 Corinthians 1:10, Ephesians 4:1-3, He desires unity
- PRAY for an understanding heart seeking to follow His pattern in all things. Seeking fellowship with God, Jesus and one another based on "walking in the light" (1 John 1:3ff)
- Lack of unity is NOT a hallmark of virtue!
- We CAN know His will!

Concluding thoughts:

- We know that Solomon's prayer was answered.
- God will answer our prayers that are properly directed toward Him (cf. 1 John 5:14-15).
- Let us pray, not only to understand His will, but also to do it **James 1:22, 25**
- AND, unlike Solomon, let us remain faithful to Him unto the very end.
